Act 172 of the 2015 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature requires that all public institutions of higher education propose to enter into a memorandum of agreement with local law enforcement agencies to clearly delineate the responsibilities and share information, in accordance with applicable state and federal confidentiality laws, regarding sexually-oriented criminal offenses, including trends, occurring involving students enrolled at institutions of higher education located in all parishes within Central Louisiana Technical Community Colleges.

I. Purpose

To enhance safety for students, employees and visitors, and better serve the residents and students in this community, ensure that investigations are comprehensive, aid in disciplinary proceedings, facilitate the prosecution of offenders, respect the legal rights of those accused of sexual assault, and provide appropriate support to victims of sexual assault, this MOU sets forth the respective roles and responsibilities of the Parties related to the prevention of and response to sexual assault.

II. Responsibilities

- A. The parties agree to work together regarding sexual assault awareness and reporting on and near the campus of Central Louisiana Technical Community College to facilitate the issuance of Clery Act required timely warnings and emergency notifications.
B. The parties agree to share relevant documentation, as allowable by federal and state law, regarding reported sexual assaults on or near campus or as experienced by students or employees of Central Louisiana Technical Community College so as to assure delivery of appropriate services, to facilitate full and fair disciplinary investigations, to prevent acts of retaliation against the victim or witnesses, and to assess special threats posed by offenders, within the respective jurisdictions as part of an overall effort to prevent the occurrence of similar crimes, to the extent such would not potentially impede the investigation or prosecution of any case or is not otherwise prohibited by law.
C. The parties agree to meet at least once a year to address the effectiveness of their prevention and response policies, procedures and efforts.

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I. Purpose


