With signature to this Memorandum of Understanding, all representatives are demonstrating a commitment to the requirements of Act 172. This agreement shall be reviewed every two years for amendments that improve its effect.

The parties agree to share relevant documentation, as allowable by federal and state law, regarding reported sexual assaults on or near campus or as experienced by students or employees of Central Louisiana Technical Community College so as to assure delivery of appropriate services, to facilitate full and fair disciplinary investigations, to prevent acts of retaliation against the victim or witnesses, and to assess special threats posed by offenders, within the respective jurisdictions as part of an overall effort to prevent the occurrence of similar crimes, to the extent such would not potentially impede the investigation or prosecution of any case or is not otherwise prohibited by law.
- C. The parties agree to meet at least once a year to address the effectiveness of their prevention and response policies, procedures and efforts.
