Policy Statement

Effective with grades earned after the semester following board approval, colleges will have a minimum of two categories of academic status: "good standing," and "not in good standing." To be considered in good standing, students must earn and maintain a 2.00 Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA). CLTCC encourages academic advising and intervention for all students not in good standing.

Definitions used in Academic Status

Adjusted Cumulative Grade Point Average (adj cum GPA): This GPA is adjusted to exclude those quality hours and grades removed from calculating a student's grade point average through a repeat/delete policy and Academic Renewal. This adjusted cumulative grade point average will include grades earned at the home institution and is used to determine a student's academic status.

Quality Hours: Quality hours are those credit hours for which a student registers and receives a grade of A - F. Credit courses for which a student receives a grade of "P," "CR," and "S" are included in earned hours but not quality hours. Courses for which students register but later withdraw with a grade of "W" are included in attempted hours but not quality hours.
